RE: MTC TIP Revision No. 2019-30 – Administrative Modification

Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Please be advised that MTC recently made several changes to the 2019 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). TIP Revision No. 2019-30 revises 56 projects with a net increase in funding of \$53 million. Among other changes, this revision:

- Updates the funding plans of 17 Transit Capital Priorities funded projects to reflect the latest programming decisions;
- Updates the funding plans of 18 projects to reflect the recent adoption of the 2020 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) by the California Transportation Commission (CTC);
- Combines the ongoing funds for five transit operating project listings and four transit preventive maintenance project listings into two new grouped listings; and
- Updates the funding plans and back-up listings for four existing grouped listings to reflect the latest information from Caltrans including the addition of \$41.8 million in State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) funding and \$3.4 million in Section 130 Railroad-Highway Crossing Program funds.

The administrative modification is financially constrained by year and MTC relies on the State's programming capacity in the amount of \$4 million in STIP funds, \$41.8 million in SHOPP funds, and \$3.4 million in Section 130 Railroad-Highway Crossing Program funds to reflect the net change in funding over the four years of the TIP.

The TIP revision entries have been emailed to your staff. MTC's 2019 TIP, as revised with Revision No. 2019-30, remains in conformity with the applicable State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality and the revision does not interfere with the timely implementation of the Transportation Control Measures contained in the SIP.


The investments described in MTC's 2019 TIP, as revised with TIP Revision No. 2019-30, make progress toward achieving the performance targets set by the region in accordance with the applicable provisions and requirements of 23 CFR Part 450.

The projects that are included in this administrative modification are not included in any other amendment that is open for public review. MTC's 2019 TIP, including the proposed Revision No. 2019-30, is consistent with metropolitan transportation planning regulations per 23 Code of Federal Regulations Part 450 and conforms to MTC's Regional Transportation Plan.

Under the delegated authority received from Caltrans, I approve this administrative modification to the Federal Statewide Transportation Program (FSTIP). This revision is consistent with the approved Administrative Modifications/Amendments Guidelines and Procedures.
