- Engagement/Program Design Process to Address Equity

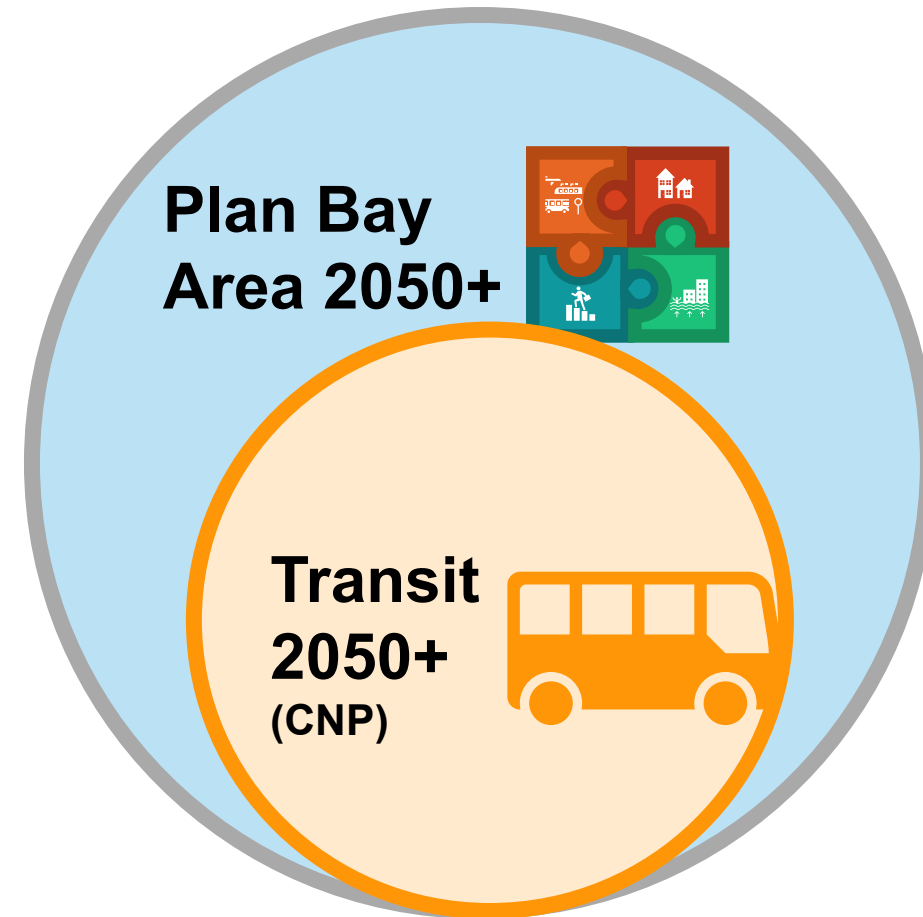
Plan Bay Area Update (PBA2050+) and Connected Network Planning (Transit 2050+)

Plan Bay Area 2050+:

Targeted refinements to all 29 strategies unrelated to transit
(led by MTC/ABAG)

Transit 2050+:

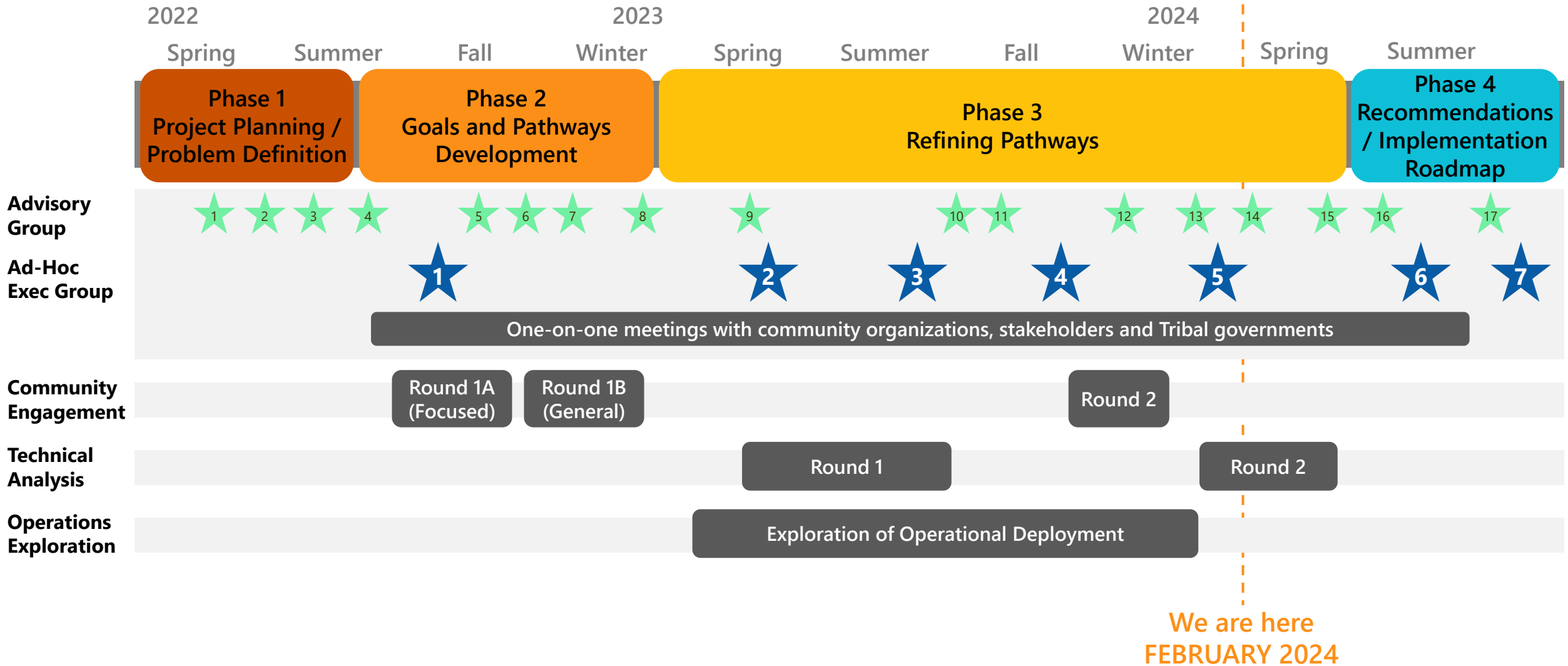
Comprehensive re-imagining of transit-oriented strategies
(co-led by MTC and transit operator team)



SB 925 (Wiener) Regional Transportation Measure Enabling Legislation

- MTC has endorsed sponsoring a regional transportation revenue measure bill this year.
- Hearings are expected to begin in March.
- Goal is to have bill enacted in 2024 allowing for placement on ballot in 2026.
- Numerous policy questions need to be resolved and the Policy Advisory Council can help inform MTC's approach.
- Staff intends to bring a monthly SB 925 update to the Council.
